City of Uvalde Recruitment Notice for Patrol Officers

The employment process will include an entrance exam, background investigation, oral interview, drug screening, physical examination and psychological examination and may be subject to a polygraph test.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS TO APPLY:

- Once hired, he/she must reside within a 45-minute response time
- Educational requirements are: High School Diploma or G.E.D.
- Must be able to read and write the English language and be licensed or eligible for licensing by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement (TCOLE) prior to hiring.
- Favorable background and work history preferred.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen and have a valid Texas Driver's License and satisfactory driving record

STANDARD BENEFITS:

Salary: \$41,787.20; after an initial 6-month probation period salary will increase to \$42,827.20
Longevity: \$2.00/ pay period equal to no more than \$4.00/ month for each year of service (maximum 26 yrs.)

Retirement: Automatic Enrollment into TMRS, with a 1.5 match after 5 years of service
